Mordialloc Creek – Installation of Wave Monitoring Recorders

Date: 15 December 2014.

Details: Mariners are advised of the installation of wave monitoring devices at several sites along Mordialloc Creek at approximate location 38°00.665'S, 144°05.070'E (WGS84).

During the works scuba divers will operate from a vessel within the Creek. When divers are operating, the vessel will display a white and blue flag (Alpha) in accordance with international standards.

Wave monitoring devices will be in place for several months to improve understanding of the wave conditions within the Creek.

Mariners are advised to exercise caution and proceed at a safe speed when navigating within the Creek during the installation works.
