City of Greater Geelong New Year's Eve Community Fireworks Displays

Date: Wednesday 31 December 2014 at approximately 2115hrs and 2400hrs midnight.

Details: Mariners are advised of two fireworks displays at the times nominated above.

The set aside for the City of Greater Geelong NYE Community Fireworks Displays comprises a 200m radius area from a barge positioned approximately at 38°8.403'S, 144°21.910'E (WGS84), north east of Cunningham Pier.

This set aside area is put in place to ensure public safety in the local port as per WorkSafe requirements relating to safety fallout areas for firework displays. The set aside area is declared between 2000hrs Wednesday 31 December 2014 and 0030hrs Thursday 1 January 2015.

Mariners are prohibited from entering the set aside area during the date and times nominated above and are advised to navigate with caution within the vicinity of the declared set aside area.

Relevant Law: The set aside area has been established under Regulations 203(1)(h) and (k) of the Port Management (Local Ports) Regulations 2004. Entry is prohibited to all persons excluding the event participants and Parks Victoria officers.
