The following Notice to Mariners is published for general information.

Stony Pier, Corio Bay
Preliminary works for salvage of vessel Cape Kimberley

Date: Between 23 November 2015 and 2 December 2015 weather permitting.

Details: Mariners are advised of preliminary salvage works to be undertaken on vessel Cape Kimberley at approximate location 38°08.667'S, 144°21.974'E (WGS84).

The work area will be designated by 3 unlit conical yellow buoys. Works include removal of materials above and below deck. Diving flags will be deployed during diving operations. On-water plant, equipment and potential hazards to navigation arising from the works will be marked and lit as per IALA standards.

Mariners are advised to navigate with caution within the designated speed limit and exercise caution within the vicinity of the works.
