

# Victorian Notice to Mariners

The following Notice to Mariners is published for general information.

**Melbourne, 3 December 2015**  
**Australia – Victoria**

**No. 233(T) - 2015**

**Port of Port Phillip**

**Stony Pier, Corio Bay**  
**Salvage of vessel Cape Kimberley**

**Date:** Between 03 December 2015 and 09 December 2015, weather permitting.

**Details:** Mariners are advised of salvage works to be undertaken to vessel Cape Kimberley at approximate location 38°08.667'S, 144°21.974'E (WGS84).

The work area will be designated by 3 unlit conical yellow buoys. Works include removal of materials above and below deck and re-floatation of the Cape Kimberley. The salvaged vessel will be towed from Stony Pier to St Helens. Diving flags will be deployed during diving operations. On-water plant, equipment and potential hazards to navigation arising from the works will be marked and lit as per IALA standards.

**Mariners are advised to navigate with caution when navigating within the vicinity of the works and while vessel is under tow.**
