

Victorian Notice to Mariners

The following Notice to Mariners is published for general information.

Melbourne, 14 December 2015
Australia – Victoria

Port of Port Phillip

West Channel
Damaged No.6 Port Lateral Pile

Date: Immediate.

Details: Mariners are advised of damage to the No.6 Port Lateral Pile in West Channel at approximate location 38°13.922'S, 144°43.466'E (WGS84). The navigation light is not operational.

On 15 December 2015, a steel, can-shaped buoy with a red day mark will be positioned as a temporary measure approximately 20 metres east of the damaged pile and lit with the characteristics Fl(2)R.4s. A temporary yellow light with the characteristics Q.Y will also be installed on the damaged pile.

Mariners are advised to navigate with extreme caution within the West Channel during the course of the repairs.
