## ESTABLISHMENT TEMPORARY VIRTUAL AIDS TO NAVIGATION

Details:

Mariners are advised that two (2) temporary virtual aids to navigation will be established in the Fairway through Port Phillip Heads for a period of six (6) hours between 14:00 and 20:00 on 27 December 2015.

Positions for temporary virtual aids to navigation are detailed in the coordinates below:

The virtual aids to navigation will be temporarily established to assist navigation for outbound yachts participating in ocean racing events. Competing yachts will be required to remain west of the temporary virtual marks.
