Notice 283(T) – 2016 refers and is cancelled.

Details: Mariners and Agents are advised that remediation works being undertaken at 6 Yarraville have been extended and are now scheduled to be completed on 27 October 2016. Consequently the temporary closure of the berth has been extended for this period.

The works will include the rehabilitation of Timber Piles. All works will be conducted during daylight hours with all plant remaining alongside each evening.
