**PORT PHILLIP ENTRANCE SEABED VIDEO WORKS AND SOUTH CHANNEL WEST SEDIMENT SAMPLING OPERATIONS**

**Date:** 03 November 2016

**Details:** Mariners are advised that seabed video works will take place at Port Phillip Heads in the Entrance, Northern Rip Bank, and Sediment sampling in South Channel West in an area to the north of the northern toeline.

The video operations and sediment sampling will be conducted on or about 04 November 2016 to 09 November 2016 in daylight hours.

Video operations will be undertaken from the John Norgate for up to two hours on either side of predicted slack water commencing on or about 04 November 2016 for a period of up to five days, subject to suitable met-ocean conditions.

Sediment sampling operations will be carried out by John Norgate; these works will take place in the period 07 November to 09 November 2016, subject to weather and the progress of the seabed video works.
