DEMOLITION / CONSTRUCTION WORKS/BEACH REPLACEMENT AT RIPPLESIDE PIER GEELONG

Date: Between November 15, 2016 to March 31, 2017

Details: Various Contractors will undertake Demolition and Construction works on Ripplside Pier, Geelong. A 15 m wide exclusion zone around the full perimeter of the Ripplside Pier will be required during the works period as well as a 30m wide exclusion zone to the Ripplside beach (see attached plan). The floating plant deployed will include flat deck barges and other small craft while the beach nourishment works will include the use of excavators and front end loaders. Works will be undertaken between 0700 - 1730 on weekdays only. Mariners are advised to keep well clear of the above works and avoid entering any exclusion zones as mapped.
