Port Phillip Heads Marine National Park - Pope's Eye Diving Works

Date: Immediate until 3 December 2016 weather permitting.

Details: Mariners are advised of diving works to be performed at Pope's Eye in the Port Phillip Heads MNP, at approximate location 38°16.625'S, 144°41.920'E (WGS84).

During the works divers will operate from a dive support vessel. When divers are operating, the vessel will display a white and blue flag (Alpha) in accordance with international standards.

Mariners are advised to keep 100 metre clearance of the dive support vessel and navigate with caution within the vicinity of the works.
