The following Victorian Notice to Mariners is published for general information.

Port of Hastings – 24th November 2016

Western Port - Depths reduced - 800 metres North of No. 19 buoy

Victorian NTM 331- 2016

Effective 24th November 2016.

Details: Mariners are advised that an area approximately 800 metres North of No. 19 buoy has had a build-up of sand extending 80 m into the main Shipping Channel, reducing depths in the vicinity to under 13.7m.

Vessels with drafts of 12.4 m and over must exercise caution in the vicinity and keep to the western side of the main Shipping Channel until further notice.
