The following Victorian Notice to Mariners is published for general information.

Port of Hastings – 03rd January 2017

Cruise Ship “Golden Princess” - Western Port

Victorian NTM 003 (T) 2017

Effective **Tuesday, 17th January, 2017.**

Details: Mariners are advised of the visit of the cruise ship *Golden Princess* which will anchor in the South Eastern extremity of the Cowes Anchorage. Her Tender vessels will operate within Cowes Anchorage and the local Port of Western Port in the waters off Rhyll, Phillip Island. Her vessels will transport passengers to and from Rhyll Pier between 1200hrs and midnight, on Tuesday, 17th.

An exclusion zone of 100 meters will be in place around the “Golden Princess “. Mariners are directed to keep outside this zone while she is in Western Port.

Mariners are also prohibited from entering the Parks Victoria mandated set aside area during the times nominated above and are advised to navigate with caution within the vicinity of the cruise ship and tender activity.
