Twelve Apostles Plunge Swim – Correction to Location of Set Aside

Date: Saturday 21 January 2017 between 1030hrs and 1300hrs.

Previous Notices: 023T – 2017 is referred and cancelled.

Details: Mariners are advised of the 1.2km Twelve Apostles Plunge Swim event defined by

the following approximate locations (WGS84) 38°37.171′S, 142°59.545′E to 38°37.350′S, 142°59.230′E to 38°37.374′S, 142°59.256′E to 38°37.189′S,

142°59.558'E within Port Campbell Bay. Temporary marker buoys will delineate the

course.

The launching, retrieving and operation of vessels in and around the Port Campbell jetty is prohibited during the event. A temporary set aside prohibiting the operation of vessels within the local port of Port Campbell extends between approximate locations (WGS84) 38°37.265′S, 142°59.469′E to 38°37.249′S, 142°59.492′E to 38°37.289′S, 142°59.496′E to 38°37.268′S, 142°59.511′E.

Mariners are prohibited from entering the set aside area during the nominated times above and are advised to navigate with caution within the vicinity of the

swim event and observe directions from the event officials.

Relevant Law: The set aside area has been established under the Port Management (Local Ports)

Regulations 2015. Entry is prohibited to all persons excluding the event officials

and Parks Victoria officers.
