St Kilda Harbour - Royal Melbourne Yacht Squadron - Repairs to Slipway

Date: **Wednesday 25 January 2017 and Friday 27 January 2017.**

Details: Mariners are advised of repairs to the slipway adjacent to Royal Melbourne Yacht Squadron located approximately at 37°51.833'S, 144°58.236'E (WGS84).

During the works, divers will operate from a dive support vessel. When divers are operating, the vessel will display a white and blue flag (Alpha) in accordance with international standards.

On-water plant, equipment or potential hazards to navigation will be marked with yellow flashing lights from sunset to sunrise in accordance with IALA standards.

Mariners are advised to navigate within the designated speed limit and exercise caution within the vicinity of the works.
