Queenscliff Blue Water Challenge Swim Events

Date: **Saturday 28 January 2017 between 0700 and 1500 hours.**

Details: Mariners are advised of swim events between Queenscliff Ferry Terminal and Queenscliff Pilot Jetty during the times noted above.

The open water swim course starts near Queenscliff Ferry Terminal at approximate location 38°15.998'S, 144°40.298'E (WGS84), extending in a southerly arc to approximate location 38°16.118'S, 144°40.130'E (WGS84), then to a turning buoy at approximate location 38°16.223'S, 144°39.886'E (WGS84), then around the final turning buoy at approximate location 38°16.078'S, 144°40.043'E (WGS84) before finishing on the beach South of Queenscliff Pier.

Marshal vessels and temporary yellow marker buoys will be in place at several locations to delineate the course.

Mariners are advised to proceed with caution in the vicinity of the swim course during the times of the event and observe directions from event officials.
