Triathlon Event - Swim course

Date: **Sunday 5 February 2017 between 0500hrs and 1200hrs.**

Details: Mariners are advised of swim events north of Elwood Life Saving Club.

The approximate locations of the near-shore swim course are 37°53.341'S, 144°58.964'E (WGS84), extending westwards to 37°53.389'S, 144°58.865'E (WGS84), then northwards to 37°53.353'S, 144°58.835'E (WGS84), before heading eastwards to 37°53.312'S 144°58.937'E (WGS84).

The course set up, swim events and demobilisation will occur between the times nominated above. Marker buoys will be in place at several locations to delineate the course which will be patrolled by designated marshal vessels.

Mariners are advised to proceed with caution in the area of the swim course during the nominated times of the event.
