The following Notice to Mariners is published for general information.

Mornington
Mornington Harbour – Visit of Cruise Ship ‘Pacific Eden’

Date: Sunday 5 February 2017 between 0800hrs and 1700hrs.

Details: Mariners are advised of the visit of the cruise ship *Pacific Eden* within the local port of Port Phillip in the waters off Mornington.

Dependant on prevailing conditions, the ship will either anchor 1NM offshore at approximate location 38°12.250’S, 145°0.820’E (WGS84) or 2NM offshore at approximate location 38°13.200’S, 144°59.500’E (WGS84).

Tender vessels will transport passengers to and from the Mornington Pier between 0800hrs and 1700hrs. The lower landing of the Pier will be temporarily set aside to allow for the safe berthing of the tenders. Public berthing and access by all other persons to the entire length of the lower landing inclusive of waters adjacent to the landing is prohibited.

Mariners are prohibited from entering the set aside area during the times nominated above and are advised to navigate with caution within the vicinity of the cruise ship and tender activity.

Relevant Law: This Set Aside Area has been established under Regulations 11(1) of the *Port Management (Local Ports) Regulations 2015 11 (2) (b)*. Entry is prohibited to all persons excluding cruise ship officials and Parks Victoria officers.

Port Manager Directions No. 1.1/2017 for the Local Port of Port Phillip have been issued pursuant to s.44G (2) of the *Port Management Act 1995*.
