Portarlington Safe Harbour - Changed Vessel Access and Construction Works

Date: **Immediate**

Details: Mariners are advised of changes to the current vessel operating procedures into the Portarlington Safe Harbour and Pier precinct.

Vessel access is currently between the existing and new Northern Breakwaters at approximate location 38°6.632'E, 144°39.252'E (WGS84).

From approximately 0700hrs Monday 20 February 2017, this Harbour access point will be permanently closed and Harbour access will be via the new Eastern entrance at approximate location 38°6.643'S, 144°39.388'E (WGS84).

A self-propelled barge with limited ability to manoeuvre will also be operating within the Harbour from this time.

Exclusion Zone buoys will be located to delineate the construction zone and the closed harbour access.

Mariners are advised to navigate with caution when approaching and within the Harbour. Mariners are also advised the self-propelled barge has right of way.
