DEMOLITION WORKS AT POINT HENRY PIER GEELONG

Date: Between February 28 and May 31, 2017.

Details: It is intended to commence activities in connection with the demolition and removal of the Alcoa Ship Loader and conveyor system at Point Henry pier. Industrial Demolition & Environmental Services are the Contractors involved in the work and they will operate from 0600 -1900 hrs,6 days a week until completion.

An exclusion zone of 50 meters is being placed around the entire perimeter of the pier (see attached diagram) in consideration of the nature of work being conducted. These will include the setting up of heavy duty cranes at the pier head, metal cutting works on elevated work platforms and the movement of heavy duty trucks up and down the pier.

Recreational mariners and fishing boats are hereby strongly advised to keep well clear of the exclusion area during the demolition works and should under no circumstances try to enter or manoeuvre under the pier whilst works are in progress.
