Royal Geelong Yacht Club Marina – Maintenance Dredging

Date: Monday 27 February 2017 to Friday 10 March 2017

Details: Mariners are advised of maintenance dredging works at the Royal Geelong Yacht Club, at approximate location 38°08.715'S, 144°22.058'E (WGS84).

Dredging works will be carried out by a cutter suction dredge within the nearshore areas east of the marina, with spoil disposal to be pumped through a discharge pipe to the adjacent beach.

The boat marina will remain open however some restrictions to boating may apply.

On-water plant, equipment or potential hazards to navigation will be marked with yellow flashing lights from sunset to sunrise as per IALA standards.

Mariners are advised to exercise caution when navigating within the vicinity of the marina.
