

## Victorian Notice to Mariners

The following Notice to Mariners is published for general information.

**Melbourne, 24 March 2017**

**Australia – Victoria**

**No. 106(T) – 2017**

**Local port of Port Phillip**

**St Kilda**

**St Kilda Harbour – Triathlon Event**

**Date:** Sunday 26 March 2017 between 0400hrs and 1200hrs

**Details:** Mariners are advised of a swim event within the precinct of St Kilda Harbour between the times nominated above.

A 1500 metre 'L' shape swim starts from St Kilda Beach north of St Kilda Pier at approximate location 37°51.774'S, 144°58.227'E (WGS84), and extends southwest to approximate location 37°51.856'S, 144°57.983'E (WGS84), then northeast to 37°51.807'S, 144°58.019'E (WGS84), then north to 37°51.644'S, 144°57.960'E (WGS84), then southeast to 37°51.768'S, 144°58.102'E (WGS84), before returning to the start point on St Kilda Beach. Other shorter swims will take place-near shore within the 1500m swim course.

Marker buoys will be in place at several locations to delineate the swim course.

**Mariners are advised to proceed with caution in the vicinity of St Kilda Harbour during the advised times and observe signage and directions from event officials.**
