The Tuesday events will take place within the following area of Sandridge Beach from approximate locations: 37°50.399'S, 144°55.163'E (WGS84) to 37°50.657'S, 144°55.182'E (WGS84) to 37°50.670'S, 144°55.017'E (WGS84) to 37°50.429'S, 144°54.950'E (WGS84).

The Wednesday events will take place within the following area of Sandridge Beach from approximate locations: 37°50.403'S, 144°55.030'E (WGS84) to 37°50.543'S, 144°55.076'E (WGS84) to 37°50.425'S, 144°54.962'E (WGS84).

Buoys will mark the course and marshal vessels will be present.

**Mariners are advised to proceed with caution in the vicinity of the events during the nominated dates and times. And observe directions from event officials.**
