

# Victorian Notice to Mariners

The following Notice to Mariners is published for general information.

**Margarets Reef – Shellfish Reef Restoration Works**

**Date:** **Friday 31 March 2017 to Friday 7 April 2017.**

**Details:** Mariners are advised of shellfish reef restoration works west of Point Cole at approximate location 37°53.900'S, 144°56.785'E (WGS84).

Works will be carried out using a barge and excavator. On-water plant, equipment or potential hazards to navigation will be marked with yellow flashing lights from sunset to sunrise in accordance with IALA standards.

During the works divers will operate from a dive support vessel. When divers are operating, the vessel will display a white and blue flag (Alpha) in accordance with international standards.

**Mariners are advised to keep 100 metre clearance of the dive support vessel and navigate with caution within the vicinity of the works.**
