Portarlington Harbour – Maintenance Dredging of Inner Harbour

Date: Tuesday 13 June 2017 to Saturday 29 July 2017

Details: Mariners are advised of maintenance dredging works within Portarlington Harbour. Works will take place south of the northern breakwater moorings, and south of the new commercial wharf at approximate locations: 38°06.677'S, 144°39.179'E (WGS84), 38°06.735'S, 144°39.199'E, (WGS84).

Dredging works will be carried out by a cutter suction dredge. Dredged material will be deposited on adjacent beaches west of the Harbour.

Works may be carried out during the day and night. On-water plant, equipment and potential hazards to navigation arising from the works will be marked as per IALA standards.

Mariners are advised to exercise caution within the vicinity of the Harbour as the dredge will have limited ability to manoeuvre.
