The following Notice to Mariners is published for general information.

Portarlington Harbour – Pile Removal Works

Date: Monday 31 July 2017 to Saturday 19 August 2017

Details: Mariners are advised of pile removal works within Portarlington Harbour. Works will take place between the northern breakwater moorings, and the new commercial wharf at approximate location: 38°06.677'S, 144°39.179'E (WGS84).

A cutter suction dredge will assist with sand removal during the works. Dredged material will be deposited on adjacent beaches west of the Harbour. Pile removal works will involve divers and a barge with excavator. When divers are operating, a white and blue flag (Alpha) will be displayed in accordance with international standards.

On-water plant, equipment and potential hazards to navigation arising from the works will be marked as per IALA standards.

Mariners are advised to exercise caution within the Harbour as the dredge and barge will have limited ability to manoeuvre.
