The following Notice to Mariners is published for general information.

Sandringham Harbour – Rock Groyne Construction

Date: 18 September 2017 to 13 November 2017

Details: Mariners are advised of construction works directly east of Sandringham harbour. The works comprise of the removal of existing timber groynes and the construction of a new 143 metre rock groyne at approximate location 37°56.486'S, 144°59.873'E (WGS84).

Works will be carried out by land-based equipment. On-water plant, equipment or potential hazards to navigation will be marked with yellow flashing lights from sunset to sunrise in accordance with IALA standards.

Mariners are advised to navigate within the designated speed limit and exercise caution within the vicinity of the works.
