Portarlington – Installation of Temporary Port Hand Buoys within the Harbour

Date: **Immediate**

Details: Mariners are advised of the installation of two temporary port hand lateral buoys within the Portarlington Safe Harbour at the southern end of the inner finger. The red, pillar shape buoys are lit with characteristic, Fl.R.3s, at the approximate locations, 38°06.736'S, 144°39.183'E and 38°06.729'S, 144°39.257'E (WGS84).

Mariners are advised to navigate with caution when operating within the Portarlington Safe Harbour.
