**Details:** Mariners are advised that maintenance dredging will take place commencing

on or about 12 October through to approximately 30 November 2017.

Dredging operations will be conducted 24 hours a day, 7 days a week in the

following areas;

South Channel

- Port of Melbourne and South East Spoil Grounds
- Station Pier Outer West
- Yarra River Services Protection (between Beacons 33/34 and 35/36)

The following vessels involved in the dredging campaign are:

- Brisbane (Trailing Suction Hopper Dredger)
- John Norgate (Survey vessel)
- QUA (Work boat)
