Kananook Creek Mouth - Maintenance Dredging Works - Extended

Date: Tuesday 28 November until Friday 1 December 2017, weather permitting.

Previous Notice(s): 299(T) – 2017 & 304(T) – 2017 are referred.

Details: Mariners are advised of maintenance dredging works to be undertaken by Frankston City Council in the vicinity of Kananook Creek entrance, at approximate location 38°08.739'S, 145°06.965'E (WGS84).

Dredging works will be carried out with a long reach excavator. Dredged material will be deposited for beach renourishment at the adjacent Frankston beach.

Plant and equipment will be stored ashore during the works.

Mariners are advised to navigate with caution within the designated speed limit and exercise caution within the vicinity of the works.
