

# Victorian Notice to Mariners

The following Notice to Mariners is published for general information.

**Half Moon Bay Boat Ramp - Dredging**

**Date:** **Monday 4 December until Tues 5 December 2017 (Tidal conditions permitting)**

**Details:** Mariners are advised of maintenance dredging works being carried out by Bayside City Council at Half Moon Bay boat ramps (two southern most ramps in Half Moon Bay) at approximate location 37°58.127'S, 145°0.591'E (WGS84).

Dredging is to be carried out in front of the public boat ramps using a long reach excavator.

Buoys will be deployed to mark the work zone. All plant and equipment will be removed from the area from sunset to sunrise.

**Mariners are advised to navigate with caution when within the vicinity of Half Moon Bay, and be advised that the two southern most boat ramps will not be accessible during the times of dredging.**
