

# Victorian Notice to Mariners

The following Notice to Mariners is published for general information.

**Corio Bay, Outer Harbour**

**Wilson's Spit Shellfish Reef – Oyster Deployment**

**Date:** Tuesday 12 December until Friday 15 December 2017.

**Previous Notices:** 300(T) – 2017 is referred.

**Details:** Mariners are advised of diving operations associated with oyster spat deployment as a part of the shellfish reef construction works north of Wilson's Spit Channel at approximate location 38°07.171'S, 144°30.385'E (WGS84).

Divers will operate from a dive support vessel. When divers are operating, the vessel will display a white and blue flag (Alpha) in accordance with international standards.

On-water plant, equipment or potential hazards to navigation will be marked with yellow flashing lights from sunset to sunrise in accordance with IALA standards.

**Mariners are advised to keep 100 metre clearance of the dive support vessel and navigate with caution within the vicinity of the works.**
