

Victorian Notice to Mariners

The following Notice to Mariners is published for general information.

Australia – Victoria

No. 022 (T) of 2018

BASS STRAIT – EAST GIPPSLAND – SNOWY RIVER

Date: Effective 30 January 2018

Details:

Mariners are advised that Cooper Energy will be undertaking diving and pipe pulling operations off shore of the Orbost Gas Plant at Newmerella, East Gippsland

The diving vessel Bhagwan Dryden (Dryden) is undertaking the works. Call Sign VHCO.

The Dryden will be located a few hundred meters off the Victorian coast from the existing Orbost Gas Plant, near Newmerella in East Gippsland in the approximate position:

Lat. 37° 48.84' South
Lon. 148° 26.30' East
(Datum WGS84)

The works include the pulling of pipes after drilling from onshore to offshore, and diving in 10m-20m of water. The Dryden will be connected to a 12-inch pipe which will have been drilled from onshore to offshore

Mariners are advised to navigate with caution in the vicinity of the Dryden and avoid operating within 500 metres of the Dryden.

It is expected that operations will commence on 30 January 2018 and the Dryden will be on site for approximately 2 weeks.
