BASS STRAIT – TORQUAY

Date: EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY

Details: Mariners are advised of five special buoys established in the approximate positions (below) of an offshore recreational fishing reef, approximately two nautical miles east-south-east of Torquay.

All five buoys will be temporarily withdrawn for the winter months in May 2018 and re-established in position in December 2018.

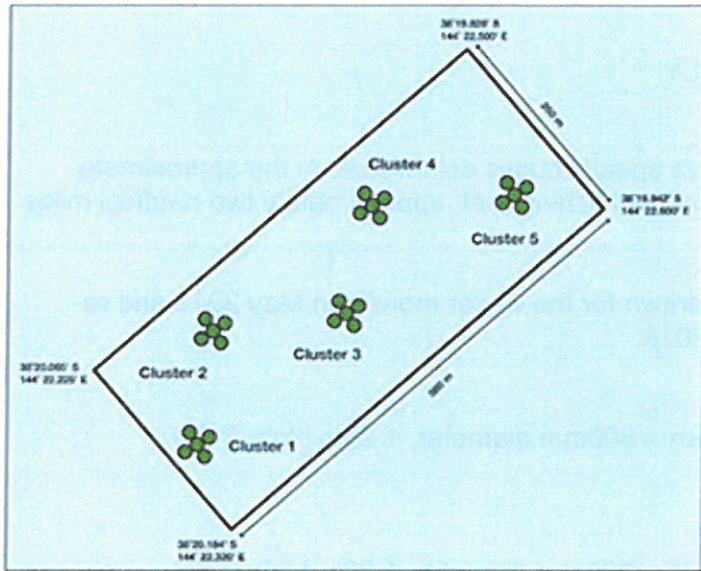
