

Victorian Notice to Mariners

The following Notice to Mariners is published for general information.

Sandringham Harbour - Dredging and Beach Re-nourishment Works

Date: Monday 12 February until further notice.

Details: Mariners are advised of dredging works directly west of Sandringham Harbour at approximate location 37°56.547'S, 144°59.468'E (WGS84).

Dredging will be carried out by a cutter suction dredge. Dredged material will be deposited, for beach renourishment, at Hampton beach.

A dredge pipeline extends 1km from the work zone to the beach and is marked with white unlit buoys. A 60m section of pipe will float behind the dredge and is marked by flashing white lights, with the remaining pipe on the seabed. On-water plant, equipment and potential hazards to navigation arising from the works will be marked as per IALA standards.

Mariners are advised to navigate within the designated speed limit and exercise caution within the vicinity of Sandringham Harbour.
