Patterson River
Patterson River Entrance - Maintenance Dredging - Extended

Date: Friday 13 April to Friday 20 April 2018, weather permitting.

Previous Notice(s): 132(T) – 2018 & 137(T) - 2018 are referred.

Details: Mariners are advised that maintenance dredging works at the entrance of Patterson River at approximate location 38°04.413'S, 145°07.174'E (WGS84) have been extended until 20 April, weather permitting.

Dredging works will be carried out by a cutter suction dredge. Dredged material will be deposited on the adjacent beach, north of the River entrance.

On-water plant, equipment and potential hazards to navigation arising from the works will be marked as per IALA standards.

Mariners are reminded to navigate within the designated speed limit and exercise caution within the vicinity of the dredging, bridge and pontoon works at Patterson River.
