The following Notice to Mariners is published for general information.

**Ramblers Rd Foreshore, Point Richards - Shell Fish Reef Installation – Works Extended**

**Date:** **Immediate**

**Previous Notice(s):** 125(T) – 2018 is referred and cancelled.

**Details:** Mariners are advised that the artificial shell fish reef installation works 100m offshore from Ramblers Road, west of Point Richards will continue beyond the expected completion date of the 30 April 2018. The continuous 130m long reef runs parallel to the shoreline from the approximate location of north east 38°06.820'S, 144°37.293'E to south west 38°06.861'S 144° 37.222'E (WGS84).

Works continue to be undertaken by a barge and divers will operate from a dive support vessel. When divers are operating, the vessel will display a white and blue flag (Alpha) in accordance with international standards.

On-water plant, equipment or potential hazards to navigation will be marked with yellow buoys and yellow flashing lights from sunset to sunrise in accordance with IALA standards.

**Mariners are advised to navigate with caution within the vicinity of the works.**
