Canoe Marathon – caution on waterway

Date: 6th May 2018

Details: Mariners are advised that the Barwon Heads Canoe Club on behalf of Canoeing Victoria are conducting a canoe marathon event on the Barwon River within the waters of the Local Port of Barwon Heads upstream of the Barwon Heads Bridge to the boat ramp opposite Minah Court, Barwon Heads.

The event incorporates a number of separate races which begin from 8am on Sunday 6th May 2018 with the main canoe event beginning at 10am on that day.

The event course is marked by temporary floats at three turning points. One set of turning floats for the canoe races will be positioned within the marked navigable channel around 100 metres north of Ozone road, jetty.

Mariners are advised to exercise caution when navigating the Barwon River whilst the Canoeing Victoria marathon race is being undertaken.

Mariners are reminded that a 5 knot speed limit applies to the waters of the local port of Barwon Heads.

Advisory signage will be placed at the Ocean Grove boat ramp (22W) and the Barwon Heads boat ramp (23W) by the event co-ordinator.
