**CORIO BAY SUB-BOTTOM PROFILE CHANNEL SURVEY**

**Date:** From May 16 – 31, 2018

**Details:** As part of the Channels Strategy Plan for the optimum utilisation of areas within the port waters of Geelong, VRCA consultants (Akuna) have employed Contractors OEMG Global to undertake a marine Aquares Resistivity Survey. This survey is undertaken by towing an active tow cable along the seabed behind a survey vessel containing current injectors and receivers. The obtained results are then digitised into an Integrated Digital Ground Model and sub-bottom profile. OEMG Global will be conducting the survey from the aluminium commercial survey vessel MV Cutloose (15.85 meters) operated by contractors Southern Divers. This vessel will operate out of Portarlington during daylight hours only between the above dates.

Mariners are requested to keep a safe distance from this vessel due to the nature of her work and may contact the vessel at all times on VHF Channel 12 or 16 if required or through the Duty Marine Controller.
