**CAPRICORNIAN DANCER AND BELLARINE EXPRESS  
TRIAL OF INCREASED SPEED IN YARRA RIVER**

**Date:** 25 May 2018

**Refers:** NTM 336 (T) – 2017 refers and is cancelled

**Details:** Port users are advised that the Port Phillip Ferries (PPF) operated Capricornia Dancer and Bellarine Express are undertaking an operational trial until 22<sup>nd</sup> of June 2018. During the trial the Capricornian Dancer and Bellarine Express will be exempted from the speed limit of 8 knots from the Yarra River Entrance Beacons (23/24) to the Southern Drip line of the West Gate Bridge and will be permitted to proceed at speeds up to 15 knots in this area.

The ferries operate between port Arlington and Victoria Harbour with scheduled runs between 0500 and 2100, seven days a week. For more information on schedules and the conduct of this trial visit the PPF website (<http://www.portphillipferries.com.au/>).
