SWEEP MAINTENANCE DREDGING WORKS

Date: Effective 6th September 2011 until 15th September 2011

Details: Mariners are advised that sweep maintenance dredging works will be conducted at berths No. 5 & 6 Yarraville between 0700 hours to 1800 hours Monday to Friday from 6th September 2011 until 15th September 2011.

The sweeping works, conducted by an excavator mounted on the jackup barge 'JUB2', may extend up to 30 metres from the berth face.

The jackup barge will be attended by the workboat 'Taurus' which can be contacted on VHF channel 12 or by mobile phone on 0409 400 722 .

Whilst not engaged in sweeping works the 'JUB2' and 'Taurus' will lay-up overnight at No. 5 or No. 6 Yarraville if available.

Mariners are advised to exercise caution when navigating in proximity to the sweeping operations.
