CLIFTON SPRINGS BOAT HARBOUR - MAINTENANCE DREDGING

Date: 14 November 2012 to 14 December 2012

Details: Mariners are advised of maintenance dredging works by the City of Greater Geelong at Clifton Springs Boat Harbour at approximate location 38°9.268' S, 144°33.198' E (WGS 84).

The dredging area extends along the northern breakwater of the harbour from the access channel to the area adjacent to the boat ramp.

Dredging works will be carried out by long reach excavator based on the northern breakwater of the harbour. Dredged material is to be deposited to the foreshore area approximately 200m east of the harbour.

Temporary buoys and silt curtain will be deployed to mark the work zone and starboard marker will be secured at the end of the silt curtain.

Mariners are advised to exercise caution and proceed at a safe speed when navigating within the vicinity of the dredge works.
