St Helens Boat Ramp Harbour, Corio Bay Geelong
Upgrade Works to the Existing Floating Pontoon Infrastructure

Date: 19 - 26 August 2013

Details: Mariners are advised of upgrade works by the City of Greater Geelong at St

Helens Boat Ramp Harbour at approximate location 38° 7.189′ S, 144°

21.577' E (WGS84).

The works include driving three new piles using pile driving barge,

replacement of an existing section of plastic pontoon and establishment of a

new section of floating concrete pontoons. Access to the boat ramp is

expected to be restricted at times to one lane.

On-water plant, equipment or hazards to navigation will be marked to appropriate IALA standards with yellow conical buoys and flashing lights

from sunset to sunrise.

Mariners are advised to navigate with caution (a speed commensurate with safe navigation) when navigating within the vicinity of the works.
