The following Notice to Mariners is published for general information.

Reconstruction of SeaRoad Ferries Terminal Berthing Wharf, Queenscliff

Date: 19 August to 28 September 2013

Details: Mariners are advised of reconstruction upgrade works to the SeaRoad Ferries Terminal berthing area at the entrance to the Queenscliff Cut located at approximate position 38°15.878' S, 144°40.302' E (WGS84).

Reconstruction works at the berthing wharf on the North East shore of the ferry terminal include:

- Removal of existing timber wharf
- Driving of new sheet pile wharf
- Driving of new anchor wall
- Installation of new tie backs between sheet pile wharf and anchor wall
- New concrete capping installation
- Back-fill behind wall
- Landscaping and vegetation of land-side area.

Floating plant (including barges and workboat) will be operating during the day and anchored at night. Barges and workboats will be lit from sunset to sunrise to IALA standards.

Mariners are advised to navigate with 5 knot speed limit, commensurate with safe navigation in the vicinity of floating plant and equipment.
