

Victorian Notice to Mariners

The following Notice to Mariners is published for general information.

Melbourne, 16 October 2014

Australia – Victoria

No. 176 - 2014

Port of Port Phillip

West Port Phillip – St Leonards

Removal of Joanna Pile & Upgrade of Clarence Pile

Date: Immediate.

Details: Mariners are advised of the removal of the pile marking the Joanna wreck at approximate location 38°12.478'S, 144°43.806'E (WGS84).

The special mark pile marking the Clarence wreck at approximate position 38°12.155'S, 144°43.395'E (WGS84) is fitted with yellow banding, top mark and lit with characteristics Fl.Y.5s.

Mariners are reminded the *Victorian Heritage Act (1995)* provides for protected no-entry zones around historic shipwrecks. It is an offence to enter, anchor, fish, trawl or dive in the protected zones of 100 metres radius for the Joanna and Clarence wrecks without a permit. The Heritage (Historic Shipwrecks) Regulations 2007 outline the offences and relevant on the spot fines applicable under the Act.
