Chelsea to Mount Martha
Pile Driving Works – Reinstatement of Aids to Navigation

Date: Immediate until Friday 20th December 2014, weather permitting.

Previous Notices: 117(T)-2014, 118(T)-2014, 120(T)-2014 & 143(T)-2014 are referred.

Details: Mariners are advised of pile driving works to reinstate the aids to navigation lost in this winter's storm event. Works will be carried out in the near shore area from Chelsea to Mount Martha as detailed in the table below.

The aids to navigation mark the offshore extent of the new Boating & Swimming Zones, 5 Knot Speed Limits, Shared Windsports Zone and No Vessels (Swimming Only) Zones.

The approximate locations (WGS84) of the piles to be driven are:
