The following Notice to Mariners is published for general information.

Port Phillip Bay - Blairgowrie to Safety Beach

Multiple swim events

Date: 10 December 2016 between 0600hrs and 1430hrs

Details: Mariners are advised of multiple swim events around piers located between Blairgowrie and Safety Beach during the times noted above. Small groups of swimmers will be circumnavigating Rye, Rosebud and Dromana Piers. Inflatable marker buoys or support craft will be in attendance.

For Rye Pier, swimmers will begin on the beach at approximate location 38°22.123'S, 144°49.338'E (WGS84), swim around the end of the pier at approximately 38°21.924'S, 144°49.383'E (WGS84) then swim to shore.

For Rosebud Pier, swimmers will begin on the beach at approximate location 38°21.171'S, 144°54.490'E (WGS84), swim around the end of the pier at approximately 38°20.998'S, 144°54.422'E (WGS84), then swim to shore.

For Dromana Pier, swimmers will begin on the beach at approximate location 38°19.910'S, 144°57.877'E (WGS84), swim around the end of the pier at approximately 38°19.831'S, 144°57.819'E (WGS84), then swim to shore.

Mariners are advised to proceed with caution in the vicinity of Rye, Rosebud and Dromana Piers during the times of the event and observe directions from event officials.
