MARIBYRNONG RIVER GEOTECHNICAL INVESTIGATION WORKS EXTENDED

Date: 21 October 2017

Details: Mariners are advised that the geotechnical investigation works, in the Maribyrnong River in the immediate vicinity of Footscray wharf, south of Shepherd Bridge (Footscray Road), is expected to be completed in early February 2018.

Works will take place from the Jack up Barge Sealift 10, from 0600 to 1800 each day, with the barge remaining on site overnight.

At night the barge will be lit on each corner with yellow lights flashing every 2.5 seconds (Fl.Y.2.5s) and each anchor marked by a buoy with a yellow light flashing 2.5 seconds (Fl.Y.2.5s).
