Beacon Cove Pier Timber Boardwalk - Temporary Works

Date: **Immediate until Friday 24 February 2018**

Details: Mariners are advised of temporary propping works to the Beacon Cove Pier Timber Boardwalk at approximate location 37°50.488'S, 144°55.893'E (WGS84).

On-water plant, equipment or potential hazards to navigation will be marked with yellow flashing lights from sunset to sunrise in accordance with IALA standards.

During the works divers will operate from a dive support vessel. When divers are operating, the vessel will display a white and blue flag (Alpha) in accordance with international standards.

Mariners are advised to keep 100 metre clearance of the dive support vessel and navigate with caution within the vicinity of the works.
