Ramblers Rd Foreshore, Point Richards - Shell Fish Reef Installation

Date: Monday 26 March 2018 to Friday 30 April 2018

Details: Mariners are advised of the installation of an artificial shell fish reef 100m offshore from Ramblers Road, west of Point Richards. The continuous 130m long reef will run parallel to the shoreline at approximate location in the north east 38°06.820'S, 144°37.293'E to the south west 38°06.861'S 144° 37.222'E (WGS84).

Works will be undertaken by a barge. During the works period divers will operate from a dive support vessel. When divers are operating, the vessel will display a white and blue flag (Alpha) in accordance with international standards.

On-water plant, equipment or potential hazards to navigation will be marked with yellow flashing lights from sunset to sunrise in accordance with IALA standards.

Mariners are advised to navigate with caution within the vicinity of the works.
