SWANSON DOCK EAST BERTH 2 – REHABILITATION WORKS

Date: 28 August 2018

Details: Port users are advised that rehabilitation works will be carried out at Swanson Dock East Berth 2 between 235 to 305 metre chainage marks from 29 August 2018 until approximately 30 August 2019. Works will take place on the wharf deck and along the wharf face.

Swanson Dock East Berth 2 between the 235 to 305 metre chainage marks, will be closed for the duration of the works. A temporary access walkway will be installed (see picture below) between the 235 to 305 metre chainage marks. Bollards in the works area will be inaccessible and not used for the duration of the works.

The works will be undertaken by **McConnell Dowell Constructors (Aust.) Pty Ltd**, the primary point of contact is, 0427 552 912, the Secondary contact is 0418 958 526.

All vessels berthing in the immediate vicinity of the works zone will require 1 lines boat for arrival.

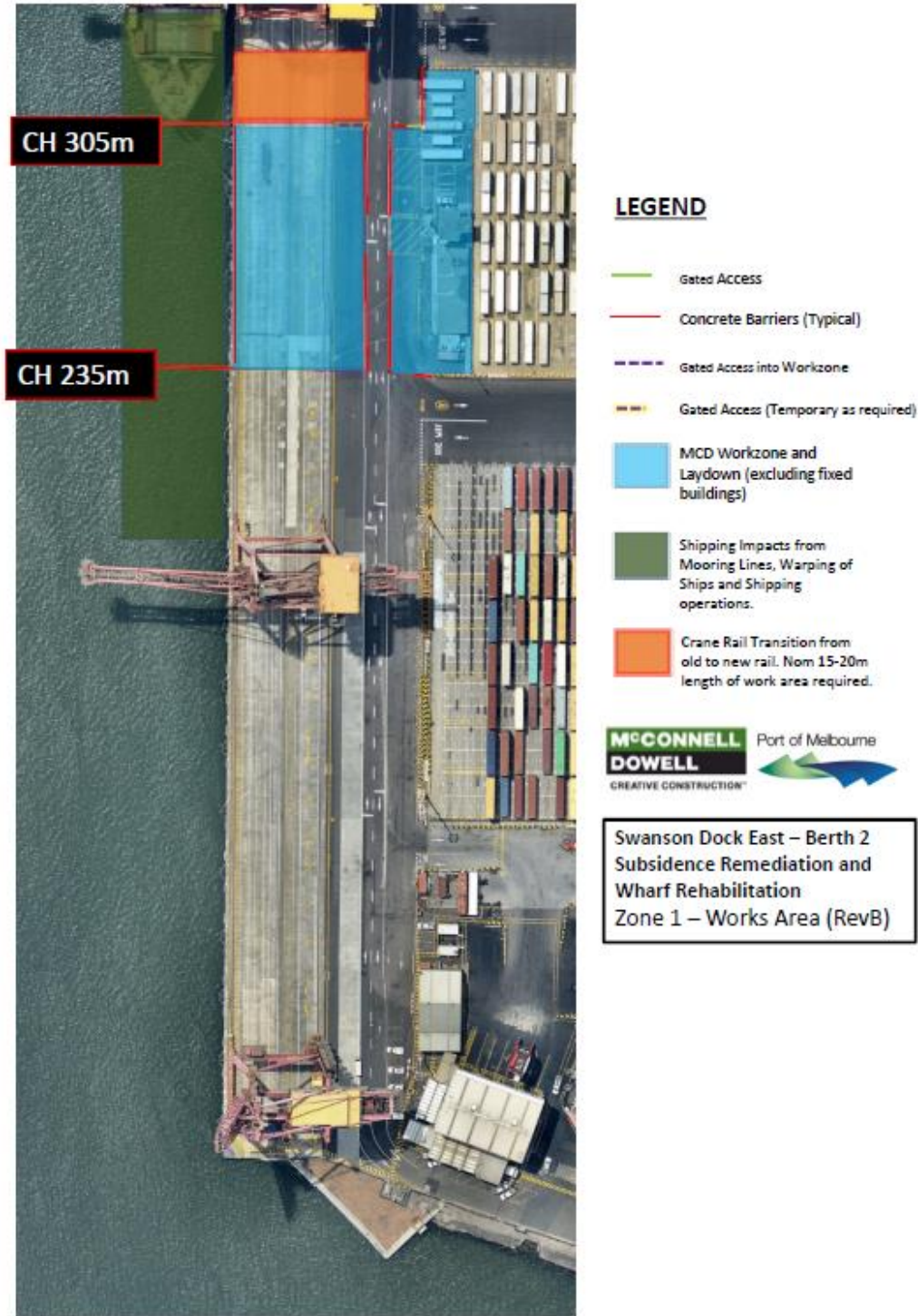

Works Zone Plan

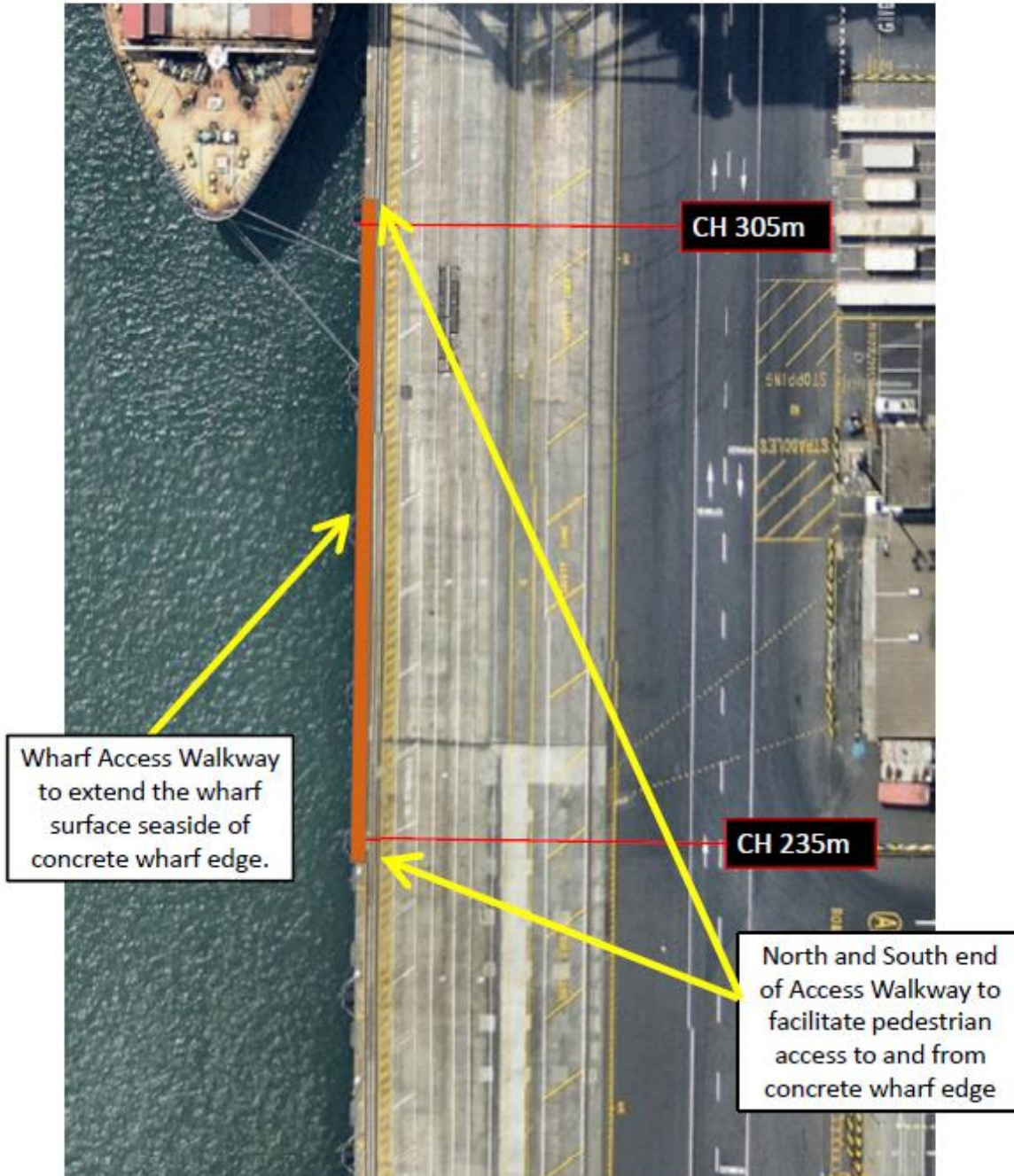
